# New Student Enrollment Procedures

## *Enrollment Criteria*

- Age 4 by September 1 (for Pre-Kindergarten applicants).
- Age 5 by September 1 (for Kindergarten applicants).
- A 2.5 Grade Point Average (GPA) on a 4.0 scale.
- Achievement test scores above the 50<sup>th</sup> percentile in reading, math, language, and on the composite score. Students without testing records will be tested before an admission decision is made.
- Positive indication on the part of the student applicant entering grades 7-12 that he/she truly wants to be a part of the Wesleyan Christian School Student body (determination made by application analysis and interviews).

- Completed application (one for each student).
- Student Questionnaire and Code of Honor Pledge (completed by students enrolling in grades 6-12).
- Registration Fee – Please refer to tuition schedule for current fee. Registration fee is refundable if the student moves out of the immediate area before the first day of classes.
- Academic records for the past year (for students entering grades 2-12). Kindergarten students must be screened prior to the family interview. WCS will contact the parents of Kindergarten students to schedule a screening date.
- Medical Records. State law requires WCS to have a copy of the certified birth certificate and immunization records on file before the student may attend class.

*Note: Your application cannot be processed until all of the above information is received.*

- Family Interview. WCS will schedule a family interview with an administrator after all forms are received. A final decision regarding enrollment will not be made until a family interview is conducted.

## *Notice of Application Status*

Due to limited enrollment and specific enrollment requirements, WCS is unable to enroll all students. Parents and students should not presume that enrollment is automatic. Parents can expect a telephone call to schedule the family interview and/or discuss openings at WCS. Applicants will be notified by mail if not accepted for enrollment.

## Code of Honor Pledge

Proverbs 18:8 – What dainty morsels rumors are – but they sink deep into one’s heart.*
